Public Measure - GH

Summary: To adopt a Revenue Purpose Statement specifying the use of revenues the Galva-Holstein Community School District will receive from the State of Iowa Secure an Advanced Vision for Education Fund.

In the Galva-Holstein Community School District, the following Revenue Purpose Statement which specifies the use of revenues the Galva-Holstein Community School District will receive from the State of Iowa Secure an Advanced Vision for Education Fund shall be adopted.

To provide funds to acquire or install information technology infrastructure (including improving buildings or sites for the purpose of accessing broadband digital telecommunications) and school safety and security infrastructure.

To provide funds to build and furnish a new school building or buildings; to build and furnish addition(s) to school buildings in the District; to remodel, reconstruct, repair, expand, and improve the school buildings in the District; to purchase and improve grounds; for demolition work; to furnish and equip district facilities.

To provide funds for the purchase, lease or lease-purchase of buildings, equipment (including transportation and recreation equipment), or technology and to repair transportation equipment for transporting students as authorized by law, to implement energy conservation measures, sharing or rental of facilities including a joint infrastructure project for the purposes of offering classes under district-to-community college programs as authorized in Iowa Code Section 423F.3(3)(c), procuring or acquisition of libraries, or opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings.

To provide funds to purchase land as part of start-up costs for new student construction program or if the sale of the previous student construction was insufficient to purchase land, and to purchase construction materials and supplies for a student-constructed building or shed intended to be retained by and used by the District.

To provide funds to make payments to a municipality or other entity as required under Iowa Code Section 403.19(2).

To provide funds for demolition, cleanup, and other costs if such costs are necessitated by, and incurred within two years of, a disaster.

To provide funds for radon testing and mitigation.

To provide funds to establish and maintain public recreation places and playgrounds; provide for supervision and instruction for recreational activities; or for community education purposes.

To provide funds for the payment of principal and interest of retirement of general obligation bonds issued for school infrastructure purposes, energy improvement loans, loan agreements authorized by Iowa Code Section 297.36, sales, service and use tax revenue bonds issued under Iowa Code Section 423E.5 or Iowa Code Section 423F.4.

To provide funds for property tax relief; and

To provide funds for other authorized expenditures and purposes as now or hereafter permitted by law and designated by the Galva-Holstein Community School District.

It being understood that if this public measure should fail to be approved by the voters, such failure shall not be construed to terminate or restrict authority previously granted by the voters to expend receipts from the Secure an Advanced Vision for Education Fund.

If approved, this Revenue Purpose Statement shall remain in effect until replaced or amended by the Galva-Holstein Community School District.

The Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session Aug. 12, 2025, at 9 a.m. Members present were Chair Devlun Whiteing and Creston Schubert. Supervisor Kyle Rohlk was absent. Whiteing called the meeting to order. A motion to approve minutes from July 29, 2025, by Schubert, seconded by Whiteing. Motion carried all voting Aye.

During public comments, Shilby Henningsen met with the board to discuss the ground around the landfill. He is very interested in being able to lease the area. The board will contact the current lease holder to terminate the lease and put this out for bid.

At 9:15 the board met at the Ida County landfill, along with Ed Sohm and Justin Georg. There was discussion on a possible burn site for the City of Ida Grove, as they need a place for their ash trees. The board will decide this at the next meeting.

Ida County resident Gordon Goodenow also met the board at the landfill. He has concerns about the dead-end road on 220th and Keystone. The board agreed they will take a look and discuss with the Engineer.

At 10:15 Roger Frank met with the board to discuss gravel and dirt road concerns. County Engineer, Jeff Williams, will look at the roads to see what they can do to improve them.

Eric Steffen, from Nelson Construction, met to update the board. Painting should be completed in the next couple of weeks, along with the sidewalk out front. They are hoping to have everything completed by the end of September.

Dale Ullrich, Veteran's Affairs' Director, met with the board to discuss Home Base Iowa Ida County Incentives Application, which helps veterans who move back to Ida County. The county would provide \$1,500 to those eligible. A motion to approve the application with the change of spouse removal by Schubert, seconded by Whiteing, motion carried all voting Aye.

A motion to approve Resolution 25-40 Abatement of taxes on parcel 11-11-402000 by Schubert, seconded by Whiteing. Motion carried all voting Aye.
